


Hillside Cottage

<u>Directions to Mariella's</u> <u>Wood & Vault Beach</u>





1. Exit the cottage and turn right, following the footpath alongside the back garden



2. Continue up the hill, be careful this can be slippery when it's raining.



3. Follow the path alongside the field, this field sometimes has pedigree South Devon cattle.




4. At the top of the path turn right and follow the road past the school and the cricket club



5. Continue to the crossroads and turn left (signposted Treveague Farm)



6. Follow the road down the hill and past the old farm buildings on the left and new house on the right



7. As the road bends around to the right go straight on into Treveague Farm




8. Continue past Treveague Farm campsite and between the cottages



9. Immediately after the farm cottages turn left



10. Follow the path around the back of the cottages, check out the wall on the left with it's herringbone stonework




11. Go through the gate and down the hillremember to close the gate behind you



12. At the bottom of the path are the 'slip stones' where the stream crosses the path. Through the gate and turn right



13. Mariella's wood is straight in front, with 2 routes, easiest is to the right side



14. The central route is steeper and zigzags, check out the bird boxes and the bluebells in the spring



15. At the top left corner of the woods is another gate, leading onto a field



16. Continue across the field, checking out the view out to sea across Gorran Haven



17. In the opposite corner of the field is another gate, take this and follow the path which brings you out onto Lamledra Hill

18. Turn right onto the road and continue up the hill for 100 yards to the car park
